## We need volunteer mentors to join our program!

We are looking for adults 20 years + who have a couple of hours a week free to spend building a fun, supportive relationship with a young person. At TRY Australia we match young people aged 7-20 who have been experiencing adversity, with an adult mentor, to have fun together and build a supportive friendship. We facilitate 12 month group and 1:1 mentoring programs. We provide screening, training and support for all mentors. We ask for on average, a 1-2 hour commitment, once a week, 3 out of 4 weeks in the month, for 12 months. Spend quality time getting to know a young person and empowering them to try new things, build on their strengths, and get involved in their local community.
