### **Entry Requirements**

All participants must:

- Be a minimum of 17 years of age (^participants cannot work with or serve alcohol until 18 years of age);
- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen;
- Not be attending school;
- Be able to read, understand and interpret written information.

## **Delivery**

This course is delivered 3 days per week for 4 weeks from all campuses. Sessions run Wednesday to Friday from 9:30am to 3:00pm.

#### **Assessment Methods**

The assessment in this course involves a combination of classroom-based workshops and practical tasks. Participants will be assessed based on the principles of competency-based training. Upon successful completion, participants will be issued with nationally recognised Statements of Attainment and a Certificate of Completion (endorsed by LCV).
