



### About this course

This qualification is delivered through an Australian Traineeship. All participants must be employed in this field with a registered employer and entered into a formal training contract through the Australian Apprenticeship Support Network.

This qualification is available under the Job Trainer initiative concession rate for eligible participants.

### Entry Requirements

All participants must:

- Attend a pre-enrolment information session
- Complete a language, literacy and numeracy assessment
- Have basic computer and internet skills
- Be able to read, understand and interpret written information.

### Delivery

An Advance trainer/assessor will visit the trainee at the workplace at least once per month to facilitate training and assessment activities. These visits will be negotiated with the employer.

### Duration

2 years full time.

### Assessment Methods

Participants will be assessed based on the principles of competency-based training. It involves a combination of on-site training, practical tasks, project work and home study. On completion, participants will be issued with a Nationally Recognised Certificate.
