Entry Requirements

A reasonable degree of physical fitness is required, as CPR must be performed continuously, for a minimum of 2 minutes, on both adult and child mannequins

Provision of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) including:

- Airway obstruction due to body position
- Appropriate duration and cessation of CPR
- Appropriate use of an AED
- Chain of survival
- Standard precautions
- How to conduct a visual and verbal assessment of the casualty

Sessions will run on Tuesdays or Thursdays.

Assessment Methods

Assessment for this course will include a practical demonstration of CPR, and a multiple choice test.
