#### About this course

#### **Delivery**

An Advance trainer/assessor will visit the trainee at the workplace at least once per month to facilitate training and assessment activities. These visits will be negotiated with the employer.

#### **Duration**

2 years full time.

#### **Assessment Methods**

Students will be assessed based on the principles of competency-based training. It involves a combination of on-site training, practical tasks, project work and home study. On completion, participants will be issued with a Nationally Recognised Certificate.
